The Economic and Monetary Affairs Committee (ECON) of the European Parliament will discuss at its meeting of 9 October 2018 (14:30 - 16:30) the draft report on the European Semester for economic policy coordination: implementation of 2018 priorities.

At this occasion, the committee will have a debate on the assessment of the 2018 European Semester as well as on the priorities for the 2019 Annual Growth Survey, which will be the basis for next year's Semester. Furthermore, the Council of the Union has adopted Country-Specific Recommendations, which directly concern your country.
