"Cultural and Creative Sectors in the EU".

To this end, the Committee on Culture and Education invites Members of National Parliaments of the EU Member States to attend an interparliamentary committee meeting scheduled for: Tuesday, 11 October 2016, from 15.00 to 18.30, at the European Parliament in Brussels.

We would appreciate it if volunteers from among the Members of National Parliaments planning to come to Brussels were willing to give short 5-minute presentations at the beginning of the two thematic panels on policies and good practices in the area concerned, in order to spark a broader debate with their colleagues.

Practical details regarding the meeting and a more detailed draft programme will be forwarded in due course to your Parliaments' representatives/services responsible for relations with the European Parliament.

We sincerely hope that you will be able to accept our invitation and we are looking forward to welcoming you to the European Parliament on 11 October 2016.
