I am writing to you in your capacity as contact person appointed by the Government of Portugal to liaise with GRETA.

In accordance with Article 36(1) of the Council of Europe Convention on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings (the Convention), GRETA monitors the implementation of the Convention by the Parties. Article 38(1) of the Convention stipulates that GRETA shall evaluate the implementation of the Convention by the Parties following a procedure divided in rounds.
