Ms Grace Fu graduated with a Bachelor of Accountancy (Honours) in 1985 and obtained a Masters of Business Administration from the National University of Singapore in 1991. She began her career with the Overseas Union Bank as an Auditor and worked in corporate planning, financial control and business development positions in the Haw Par Group.

In 1995, Ms Fu joined the PSA Corporation and took on responsibilities in finance and marketing. She assumed the position of Financial Controller of PSA Corporation in 1998. Ms Fu was appointed the Chief Executive Officer, Singapore Terminals in 2003. Before she left the PSA Group in 2006, Ms Fu was holding the appointment of Chief Executive Officer, PSA South East Asia and Japan, where she was responsible for the business performance of PSA's terminals in Singapore, Thailand, Brunei and Japan.

Ms Fu was elected as a Member of Parliament in June 2006 for the Group Representation Constituency of Jurong. In August 2006, Ms Fu was appointed Minister of State for National Development. Ms Fu was promoted to Senior Minister of State in 2008, and was appointed in the Ministry of Education, concurrently. In 2011, she was elected as the Member of Parliament for the Single Member Constituency of Yuhua and appointed as Senior Minister of State in the Ministry of Information, Communications and the Arts, and the Ministry of the Environment and Water Resources. She was also appointed Chairperson of Women's Wing of the People's Action Party. On 1 August 2012, Ms Fu was appointed Minister, Prime Minister's Office and Second Minister for Foreign Affairs and the Second Minister for the Environment and Water Resources.

In addition, Ms Fu sits on the boards of the Peoples' Association and the Chinese Development Assistance Council. Further, she is involved in or has been involved in a number of committees including the Ministerial Committee on Ageing, the Economic Strategies Committee, the Sino-Singapore Tianjin Eco-City and the National Integration Committee.
