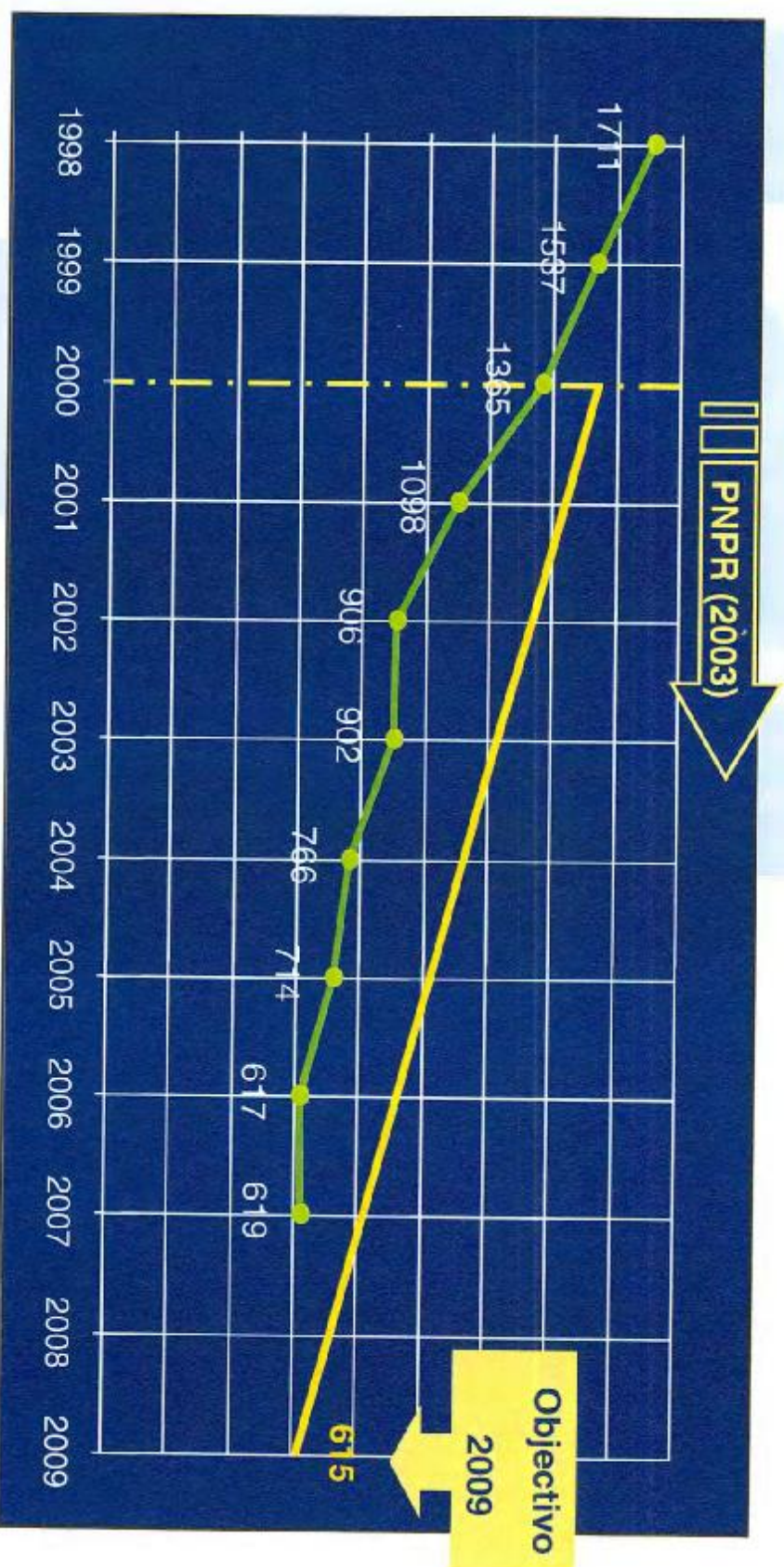
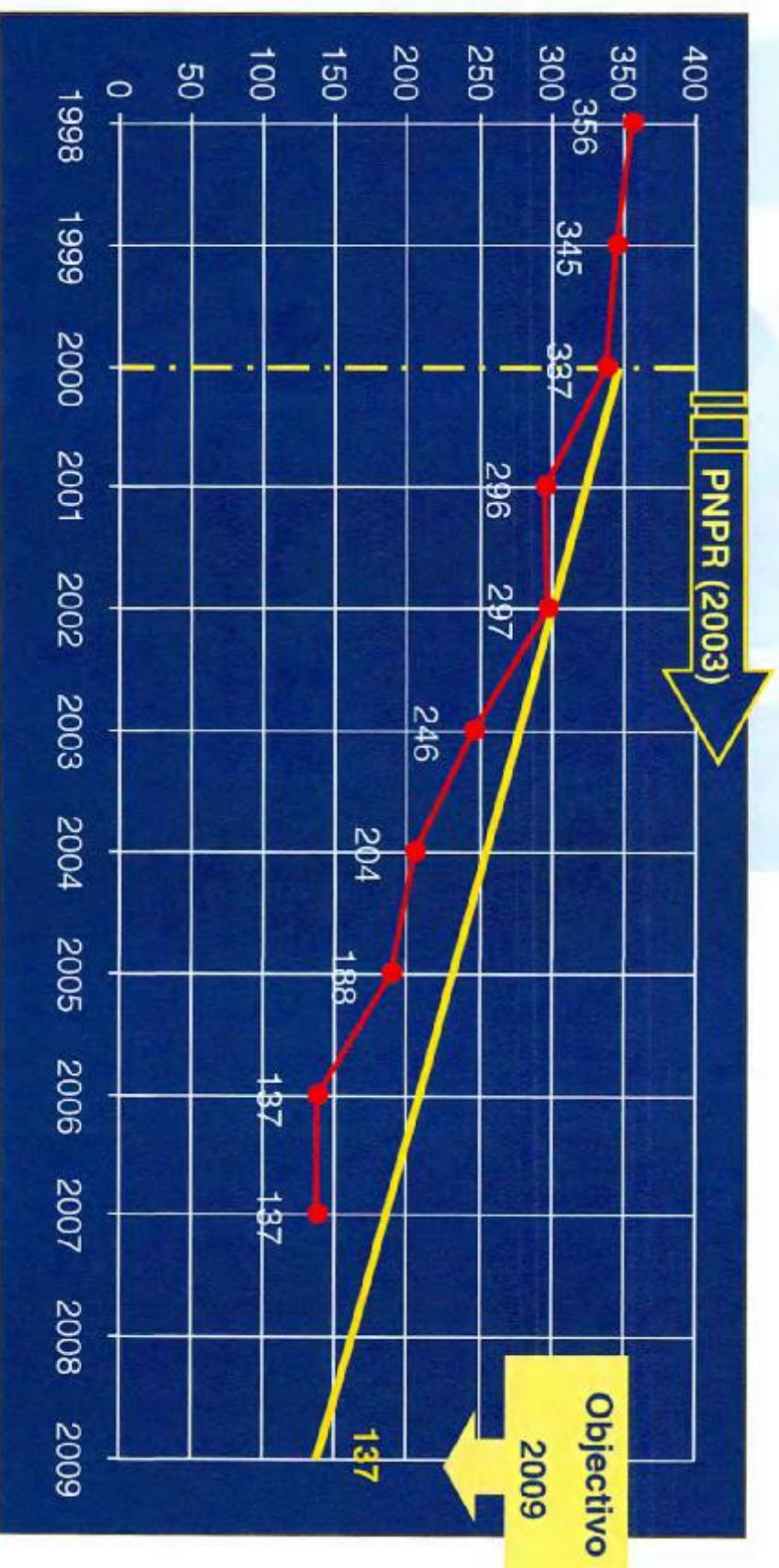

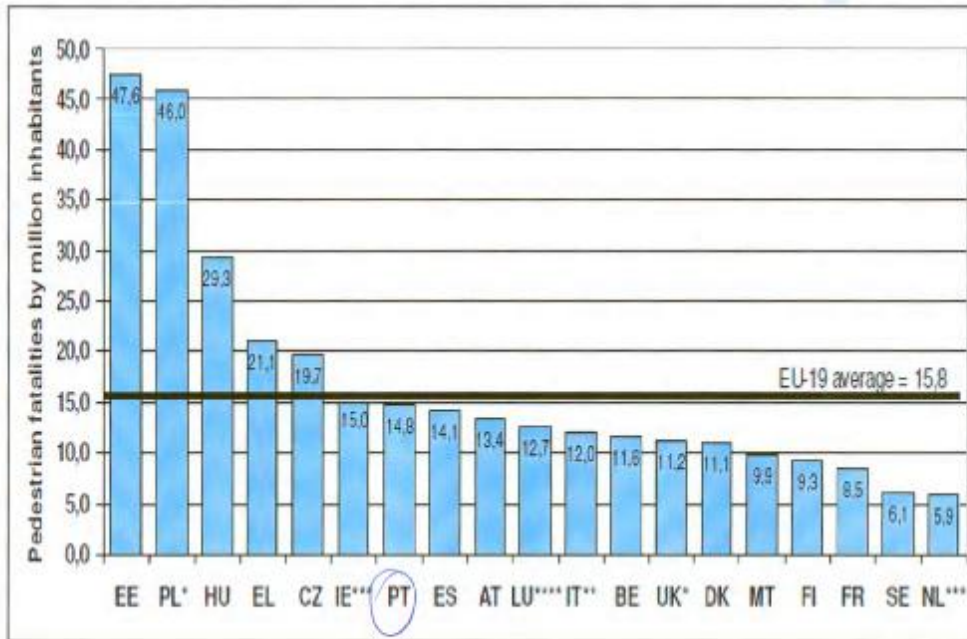
Entre 2000 e 2007 o número de feridos graves diminuiu 55%

Entre 2000 e 2007 o número de vítimas mortais diminuiu 59%.

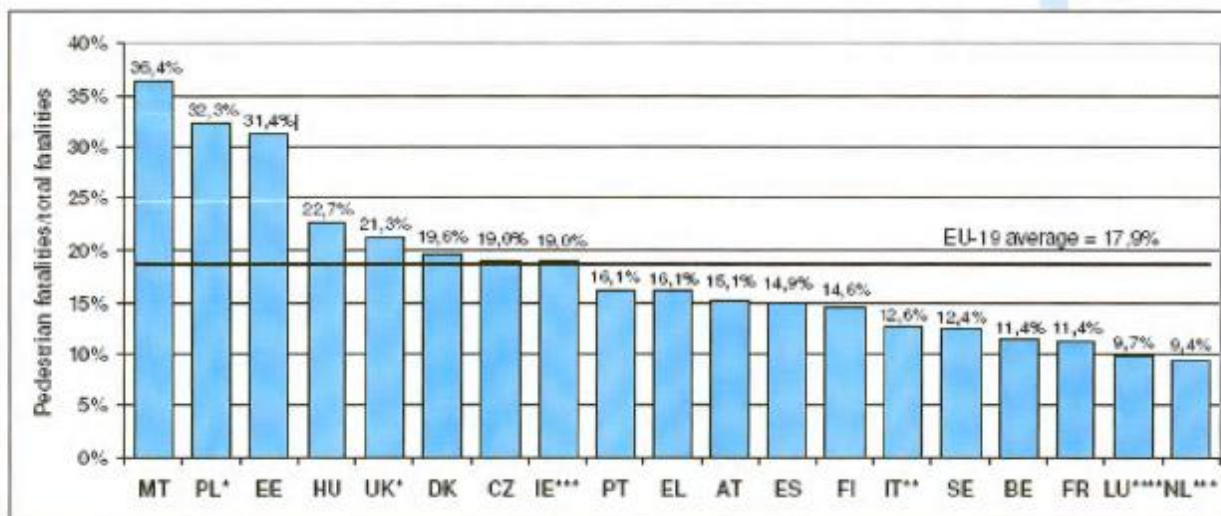
Figure 2: Pedestrian fatalities per million inhabitants by country, 2006

Figure 1: Motorcycle and moped rider fatalities per million inhabitants, 1997 versus 2006⁴

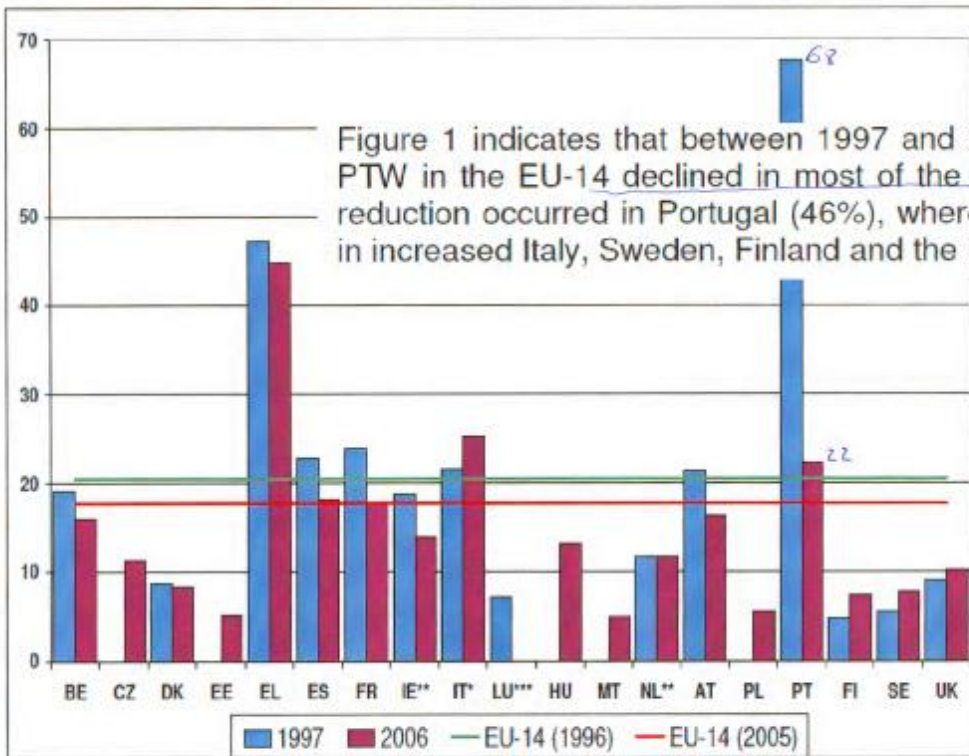
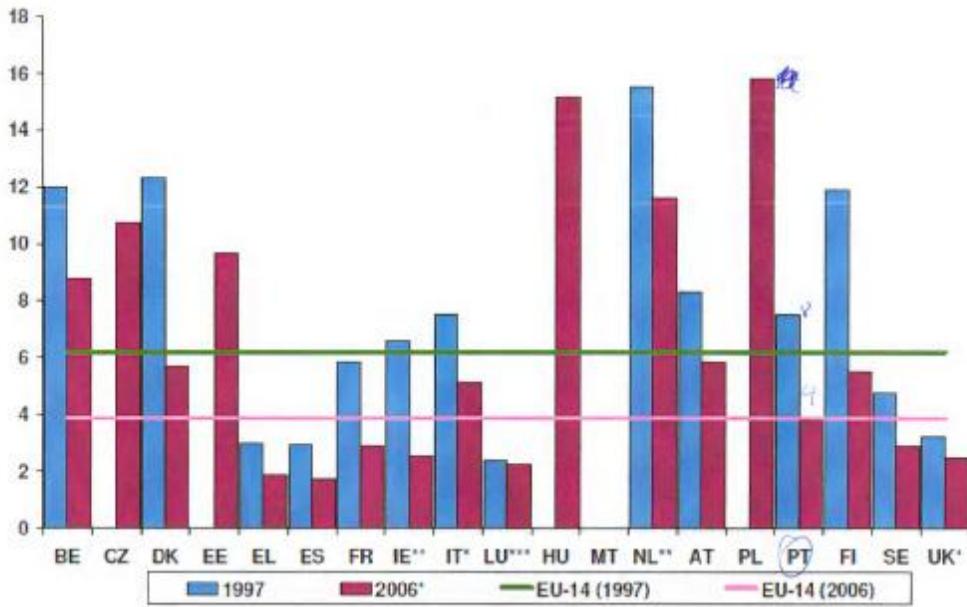


Figure 1: Bicycle fatality rates, 1997 and 2006¹
