Presidente do Conselho de Administração e da Comissão Executiva da Fundação Francisco Manuela dos Santos, Jaime Gama nasceu a 8 de Junho de 1947 na freguesia da Fajã de Baixo, concelho de Ponta Delgada, nos Açores.

Licenciado em Filosofia pela Universidade de Lisboa, ocupou várias pastas ministeriais em diversos Governos (Administração Interna, Defesa Nacional e Negócios Estrangeiros).

Foi Deputado de 1975 a 2011 e exerceu as funções de Presidente da Assembleia da República, sendo, por inerência, membro do Conselho de Estado.

Atualmente, integra o Conselho Geral da Universidade de Lisboa, o Conselho Estratégico do Instituto de Estudos Políticos da Universidade Católica Portuguesa, o European Council on Foreign Relations e o Aspen Ministers Forum. É Senior Strategic Counsel do Albright Stonebridge Group.

É, ainda, Presidente do Conselho de Administração do Novo Banco dos Açores e Presidente do Conselho Geral e de Supervisão do jornal eletrónico Observador.

Possui diversas condecorações nacionais e estrangeiras e é Chanceler das Antigas Ordens Militares Portuguesas

Jaime Gama is currently Chairman and President of the Board of the Francisco Manuel dos Santos Foundation, Chairman of the Board of the bank Novo Banco Azores, and Chairman of the Supervisory Board of the digital newspaper Observador. He is also Senior Strategic Counsel at Albright Stonebridge Group.

Mr. Gama was recently appointed Chancellor of the ancient Military Orders of Portugal by the Portuguese President.

He is a member of the Aspen Ministers Forum and of the European Council on Foreign Relations.

He holds seats on the Strategic Council of the Institute of Political Studies of the Catholic University of Portugal and on the General Council of the University of Lisbon.

Mr. Gama served as Minister of Foreign Affairs, Minister of Home Affairs, Minister of Defense, and Minister of State. He was elected Member of Parliament between 1975 and 2011, and served as the Speaker of the Parliament from 2005 to 2011.

He was Chairman of Bertrand publishers and served on the Board of Portugal Telecom International.

Mr. Gama holds a degree in Philosophy from the University of Lisbon
