Excelentíssima Senhora Presidente, cara colega,

Temos o prazer de anunciar que a Semana Parlamentar Europeia (SPE) de 2015 se realizará a 3 e 4 de fevereiro de 2015 nas instalações do Parlamento Europeu, em Bruxelas. A SPE reunirá deputados de toda a União Europeia para debater questões económicas, orçamentais e sociais.

Durante a SPE, realizar-se-ão dois eventos. O primeiro evento será a *Reunião Interparlamentar sobre os Ciclos do Semestre Europeu de 2014 e 2015*, que terá lugar no contexto da elaboração dos relatórios do Parlamento Europeu sobre as prioridades do próximo ciclo do Semestre, com base na Análise Anual do Crescimento. Terá por objetivo reforçar a dimensão democrática do processo de decisão da UE e intensificar a cooperação entre os Parlamentos nacionais e o Parlamento Europeu, a fim de controlar as ações do executivo, tanto a nível nacional como a nível europeu, no âmbito do ciclo do Semestre.

O segundo evento será a *Conferência Interparlamentar nos termos do artigo 13.º do Tratado sobre Estabilidade, Coordenação e Governação na União Económica e Monetária (TECG)*. Esta Conferência será organizada e presidida conjuntamente pelo Saeima da República da Letónia e pelo Parlamento Europeu. Terá por objetivo a realização de um debate sobre questões cobertas pelo artigo 13.º do TECG, colocando a ênfase no novo plano de infraestruturas da União Europeia, nas melhores práticas para a aplicação do pacto orçamental e na dimensão social da União Económica e Monetária. A Conferência destina-se igualmente a desenvolver a cooperação entre os Parlamentos nacionais da União Europeia em relação a questões abrangidas pelo TECG.

Esperamos sinceramente que o Parlamento a que V. Ex.ª preside esteja representado em ambos os eventos. Estamos convictos de que a participação de V. Ex.ª contribuirá para um debate profícuo. Figuram em anexo os anteprojetos de ordem do dia dos dois eventos. Outras informações circunstanciadas sobre a SPE serão comunicados em tempo oportuno.



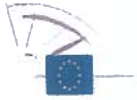
