I am pleased to inform you that the European Parliament's Committee on Regional Development will organize an interparliamentary committee meeting with the committees of the Member States' parliaments responsible for regional development and cohesion policy, on the *"Future Cohesion Policy in the light of new legislative proposals"*.

The meeting will take place on **6 October 2011 from 15.00 to 18.30** in the European Parliament's premises in Brussels.

As you know legislative proposals due to be adopted in July by the European Commission are of particular importance for cohesion policy as they will define the framework for the next programming period. The October meeting will therefore, be the first occasion for national Parliaments to express their views on the legislative package and I am sure that our deliberations will allow for a strong parliamentary input into the ongoing debate on the future of the cohesion policy.


