“Europe in search of leadership”

Europe, weakened by the Covid-19 pandemic, faces a real challenge to rebuild its economic positions and maintain its relevant role in international relations. However, in order to be able to act as a strong player on the global stage, Europe must first work out the necessary internal compromise in order to speak with a single, coherent voice. At this point, it is strong leadership that appears to be essential in achieving such a consensus.

Where do we search for such leadership? Who will be able to bear the burden of setting the right direction for Europe? There are certainly many people willing to do so. There are also many challenges arising from the current pandemic situation: effective vaccination policy, implementation of the Recovery Plan, relocation of the necessary goods' production from other regions in the world to Europe, protection of national capital, sustainable development of the continent, or reducing the social differences deepened by the pandemic.

Not all of these difficulties can be solved at the EU level. Moreover, it is necessary to consider the priorities for the time after the pandemic: European values or national interests? What awaits Europe at the beginning of the new decade?

The 30th Economic Forum will be held on 7–9 September 2021 in Karpacz.

The Economic Forum organized by the **Foundation Institute for Eastern Studies** is the largest conference in Central and Eastern Europe. For almost 30 years now, the Forum has gathered political, economic and social leaders from over 60 countries around the world.

The Economic Forum serves as a platform owing to which the most important figures in European politics and economy can exchange their views. The characteristic atmosphere of the Forum, resulting in its many years' existence, favours the development of cooperation between the Member States of the European Union and their neighbours. Each year important declarations are made during the Forum, which is why the sessions attract the media from all over the world the most, as well as their effects are echoed among experts long after the Forum's closure.

The programme of the Economic Forum includes over 200 debates, 6 plenary sessions, conversations with the most important guests, workshops and presentations.

Events of the Forum

The following thematic paths have a permanent and well-established position in the Economic Forum program:

Healthcare Forum

For over 11 years, it has enabled the exchange of experiences and the presentation of the new ideas for managing and financing the health protection system, showing how important this aspect is in the public debate.

Regions Forum

Since 2007, it has been an integral part of the Economic Forum. It is a platform for the exchange of views and a meeting place for leaders of local governments and regional elites from Central and Eastern Europe with the business and scientific community.

Europe of the Carpathians

Organized as part of the Economic Forum together with the Sejm of the Republic of Poland, the event brings together representatives of state authorities, as well as local governments from all countries involved in the broadly understood Carpathian subject matter.

Polish Community Economic Forum

Created in cooperation with the Senate of the Republic of Poland in 2015, it gathers the representatives of state authorities, Polish communities and national non-governmental organizations.

Report of the Warsaw School of Economics and Economic Forum

The most important document that will be presented during the session of the 30th Economic Forum will be the **Report of the Warsaw School of Economics and Economic Forum 2021**.

The report is the most comprehensive study on the state of the economy and Poland in 2021. The material was prepared by experts from the leading university of economics in the country - the **Warsaw School of Economics**.

In 2021, the 4th edition of the Report will be presented, focusing on such topics as: the green opening in the energy sector of CEE countries, health care, the response of the region's governments in terms of tax policy to COVID-19 and the development trajectory of individual economies in 2015-2020.

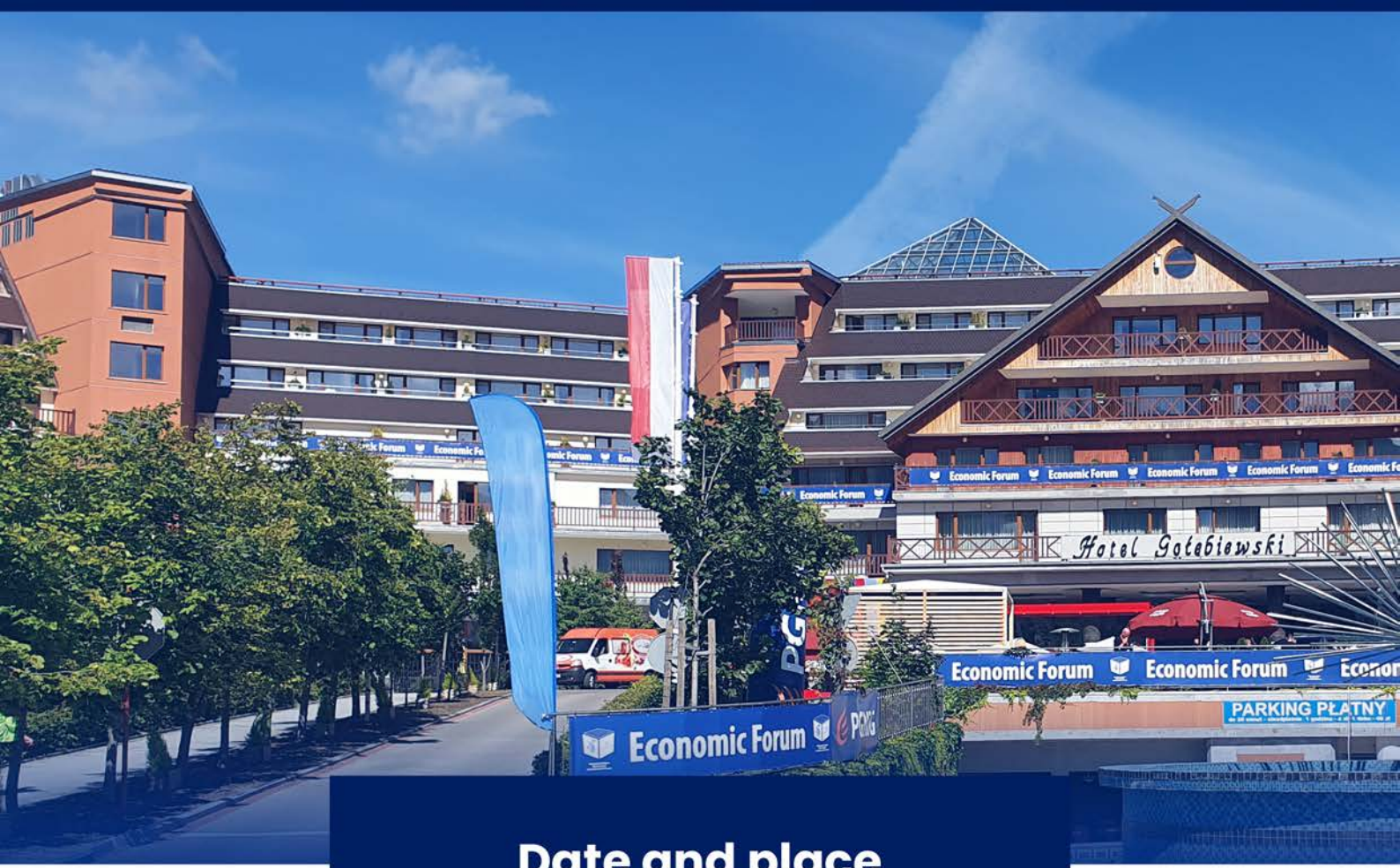


Awards of the Economic Forum
