Attended intermediate secondary school; passed skilled worker's examination in 1974; worked as an electrical mechanic and engineer; youth representative and works council member; elected chairman of the IG Metall trade union local youth committee and the youth organisation of the German Trade Union Confederation (DGB) in Munich; studied from 1979 to 1984, graduating with a degree in economics and socio-economics.

Member of the IG Metall trade union; helped organise the 1984 strike with the goal of introducing a 35-hour working week; employed as trade union secretary for the Stuttgart IG Metall trade union after graduating; first representative (elected position) of the Schweinfurt branch of IG Metall from 1995 to 2010.

Member of the IG Metall trade union since 1972; member of the Social Democratic Party of Germany (SPD) for 30 years; expelled from the SPD in 2004; founded the Electoral Alternative for Work and Social Justice (WASG); deputy chairman of The Left Party from June 2007 to May 2010; chairman of The Left Party from May 2010 to June 2012.

Member of the German Bundestag since 2005; deputy chairman of the Left Party parliamentary group in the Bundestag from 2005 to 2009 and from 2013 to 2018; head of the parliamentary group's Health and Social Security working group from 2005 to 2010; Member of the Committee on Labour and Social Affairs since 2012; Member of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Energy since 2013; head of the working Group Economic Affairs, Labour and finance from 2013 to 2018; Chairman of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Energy since 2018; Chairman of the Committee on Climate Action and Energy since 2021 until the present day
