 of Human Rights in the SADC Region.
- Explore ways for effective utilisation of these tools and create a platform for parliamentarians from the SADC region and the European Union to share examples of good practices, fostering a culture of cross-learning and benchmarking.
- Build commitment of parliaments to assume a key role in democratic strengthening globally.

We would like to invite you to speak at the *Discussion Panel One - Establishing and Strengthening Parliamentary Human Rights Committees,* which will take place on **Wednesday, 8 November 2023 between 12.00 to 13.00 CET.** The session will look into the











mandate, functions, composition and working methods of human rights committees as well those resources that are critical for ensuring the effective functioning of the committees. Considering an extensive mandate and functions of the Committee on Constitutional Affairs, Rights, Freedoms and Guarantees of the Parliament of Portugal - including in conducting hearings, inquiries, engaging citizens in the process and other mechanisms - sharing of its experience and practices will greatly contribute to the workshop discussions.
