The study from 2021 found an immense impact of Open Source Software on the European economy - a contribution of up to €95 billion to the EU's GDP. What is the public sector's role?



There are both national and regional policies supporting Open Source in the public sector in the EU. What is their effectiveness?















Contributors by EU Member States

















OSS contribution to EU economy was €65 - €95 billion - between 0.5% and 0.7% of EU's GDP


