


Economic growth and societal benefit

Working for Parliament

From my personal experience:

- 1. Essential to build up and maintain a strong network with society
- 2. Collect signals consistently from society
- Use position in Parliament to pressure government for further ambition
- 4. Ensure results on the better regulation agenda, i.e. SME-test



Added value of Actal

- 1. Structural and objective identification of obstacles for businesses, citizens and professionals.
- Transparent and independent opinions on less burdensome alternatives supporting debate on policy choices.
- 3. Validation of impact assessments on regulatory costs
- 4. Recommendations to achieve more progress on the better regulation agenda.



Key elements Dutch approach

- 1. Strong political commitment
- 2. Net reduction target
- 3. Common methodology
- 4. External, independent advisory board (Actal)



Actal

- External, independent advisory board
- Three tasks:
 - 1. Ex ante scrutiny
 - 2. Regulatory burden audit
 - 3. Strategic advice on existing legislation

Advices Cabinet, Parliament and municipalities



Scrutiny framework Actal

1. Zero Option

✓ What goes wrong without the policy under consideration (i.e. if the Zero Option is adopted)?

2. Less burdensome alternatives

- Have the effects on regulatory burden been calculated correctly?
- ✓ Has the least burdensome alternative been adopted? If not, why not?

3. Policy, implementation and inspection

Have the effects of implementation and inspection been taken into account?



EU legislation

Burden:

 EU-level cannot be ignored: 50% of the regulatory costs for Dutch business stems from EU legislation and implementation.

Aim:

- Tackle regulatory costs from the EU through an ambitious EU approach (RegWatchEurope)
- Achieve a less burdensome implementation (in NL) of EU legislation.
