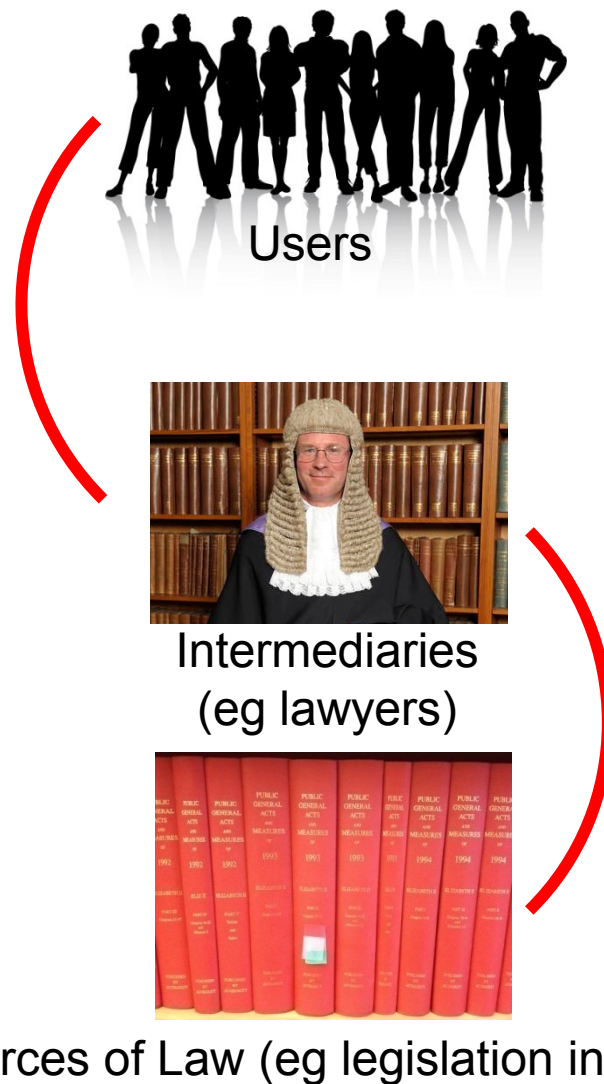

Intermediaries (eg lawyers)

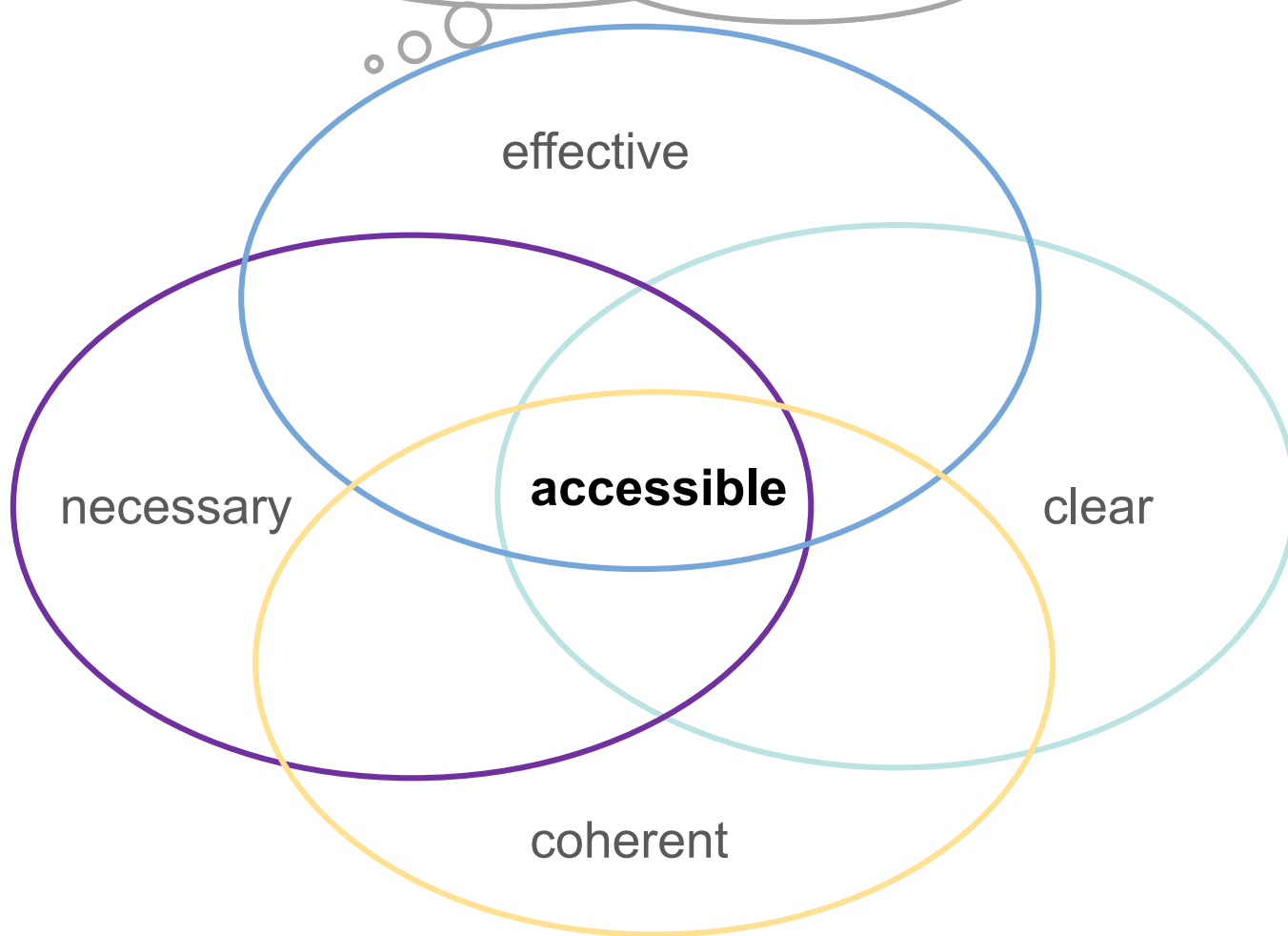


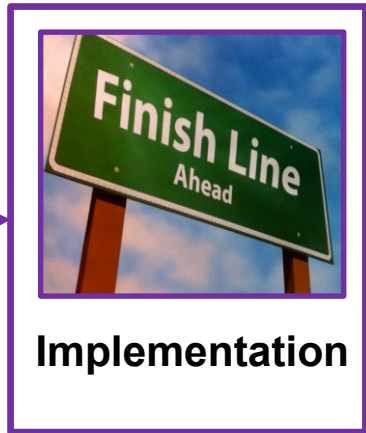
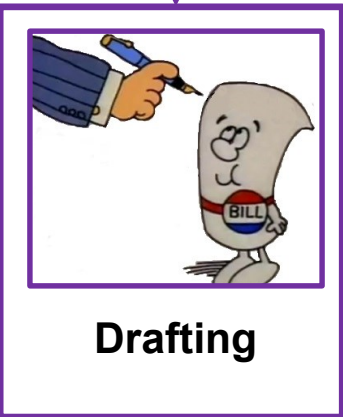
