



Invitation to Interparliamentary Conference on Transforming the EU's Food Systems on 11-12 September 2025

Dear colleague,

Under the Danish Presidency of the Council of the European Union, the Danish Parliament is pleased to invite you to an interparliamentary conference on the future of food production in Europe, taking place on **11–12 September 2025** in **Billund, Denmark**, at **LEGOLAND Hotel & Conference**.

The conference will explore how to enhance European food security and resilience, with a particular emphasis on the role of **plant-based foods** and **biosolutions** in driving transformation in the face of global challenges.

On the first day, participants will join a **company visit to KMC**, a leading Danish producer of potato-based ingredients, followed by a **dinner** in the evening.

The second day will be the main conference day and will include the following sessions (subject to change):

- **Opening Session** – Transforming the EU's food systems - can plant-based foods and biosolutions enhance food security and resilience?
- **Kick-off Presentation** – Food security and resilience - why a transformation of the agri-food sector is needed
- **Session I** – How to reduce strategic dependencies and strengthening European food security
- **Session II** – The way forward - the potential of plant-based foods and biosolutions in Europe – a political perspective

In this case, the Green Card initiative aims to invite the Commission to present an **EU action plan for plant-based foods**. Please find the text enclosed.

We sincerely hope you will consider supporting this appeal to the European Commission and endorsing the Green Card initiative.
